**Rules**

Dry work: (60 pts) May consist of these maneuvers:

- dismounting on right side and picking up foot—10 pts
- loading horse in trailer and backing out—10 pts
- picking up a rope and dragging an obstacle through a pattern—10 pts
- crossing a bridge/obstacle—10pts
- performing an assigned reining pattern—10 pts

Reining pattern will be posted prior to the start of the event

Cow work: (60 pts)

- work cow on rail, following reining pattern—10 pts
- turn cow to center of arena, circle both directions, following reining pattern—10 pts
- rope and stop cow—20 pts
  - 1 loop only
  - dally roping only

A 6-minute time limit will be set on each competitor. Time will begin when the competitor enters the arena and ends when the horse stops the cow and the rope comes tight. Ties will be decided by the shortest time. Competitors will be judged on level of control shown in performing the tasks and their ability to control the cattle in an organized and timely manner. Cattle will be gate-cut to competitors and used only once in the competition. Refusing your stock will end your run. All judge's decisions are final.
