Amy moved to approve the minutes from the October 3rd, 2023 meeting, Ray seconded, all ayes, motion carried.

Ray moved to have Statice moved to Monday of Fair week, Nate seconded, all ayes, motion carried.

Laurie talked more about having the dog show moved into the big barn. This would help with the no dog rule in or around the livestock barns during fair. Will also be beneficial no matter the weather the dog show could proceed. Was mentioned to move the dog show to a different day to be able to use the big barn ahead of the pen setup. The thought was to have it on the same day as the Exhibit Hall Setup, which is usually on the Saturday before Fair, this would also create foot traffic for the Dog Show.

Amy moved to have the Dog Show inside the big barn on July 13th, 2023, same day as the Exhibit Hall Setup, Ray seconded, all ayes, motion carried.

Ray moved to have food vouchers or a punch card for superintendents during fair, Amy seconded, all ayes, motion carried.

Josh brought up that there are questions for the decisions to be made on some things to improve Fair. However, without the superintendents of those areas, and FFA advisors, being at the meeting some decisions were put on hold.
