

WHAT'S NEW TO THE 2026 CROOK COUNTY FAIR

1. REMINDER

- a. Premium checks will only be honored for 90 days after the date written. Any checks not picked up or cashed will be forfeited after 90 days.

2. DRESS CODE

- a. Youth Exhibiting animals at the Crook County Fair are expected to showcase their animals with pride and professionalism. All youth must dress for success, proper attire is required as the following nice dress shirts, nice pants (without holes), and boots or leather shoes. No tennis shoes or sandals. For FFA Showmanship you must follow FFA Official dress, which includes Official FFA Blue Jacket, White collared shirt or blouse, Official FFA tie or scarf, Black slacks or pants, black closed toes or as stated by their FFA Advisor. Participants in the 4-H dog show, Youth Horse Show, Youth Dairy Goat/Cattle Show may follow the dress code according to that section.

3. Horse Show

- a. All 4-H & FFA exhibitors must be safety certified and endorsed by a certified 4-H leader designated by the Crook County 4-H Educator. Certification must be present at check-in.

4. Poultry Show

- a. Barnyard Mix breeds are to be classified as follows: any fowl that does not fall into a pure breed Category as outlined by the American poultry Association Standard of Perfection.

5. Market Animal Insurance on 4-H/FFA Animals going to state fair. REMEMBER this is only a reaccommodation!

- a. *“The Seller /Exhibitor understands that the sale committee and Buyer are not responsible for the well-being of livestock held and reserved by the Seller/Exhibitor for State Fair. Sellers that choose to participate in State Fair do so with the understanding that if the livestock is not delivered live to the Buyer or their designated processor, that the sale will be considered null and void. The sale committee recommends but does not require livestock held and reserved for State Fair to be insured to protect the Seller/Exhibitor's investment.”*
