Jr. Livestock Sale Policy

Twila moved to accept the Jr livestock Sale Policy as follows: **The Seller /Exhibitor understands that the sale committee and Buyer are not responsible for the well-being of livestock held and reserved by the Seller/Exhibitor for State Fair. Sellers that choose to participate in State Fair do so with the understanding that if the livestock is not delivered live to the Buyer or their designated processor, that the sale will be considered null and void. The sale committee recommends but does not require livestock held and reserved for State Fair to be insured to protect the Seller/Exhibitor's investment,** Josh seconded the motion, all ayes, motion carried.

Dress Code

Twila moved to accept the Dress Code as follows: **Youth Exhibiting animals at the Crook County Fair are expected to showcase their animals with pride and professionalism. All youth must dress for success, proper attire is required as the following nice dress shirts, nice pants (without holes), and closed toe shoes for safety. For FFA Showmanship you must follow FFA Official dress, which includes Official FFA Blue Jacket, White collared shirt or blouse, Official FFA tie or scarf, Black slacks or pants, black closed-toed shoes or as stated by their FFA Advisor,** Josh seconded the motion, all ayes, motion carried.

Mini Cattle to 2027 Crook County Fair

Twila moved to accept adding Mini Cattle to 2027 Crook County Fair as follows: **mini cattle entering the Market beef must be under the minimum of 48", under 1100 lbs. to qualify as a mini subject to classification at weigh-ins but must be over a year old, under 2 years of age to be allowed to sell,** Josh seconded the motion, all ayes, motion carried.

Poultry Class

Josh moved to accept backyard mix to the 2026 Crook County Fair, Twila seconded the motion, all ayes, motion carried.

Rabbit Table

Josh moved to purchase a Large Rabbit Table from KW Cages for the Rabbit Show, Twila seconded the motion, all ayes, motion carried.

Josh moved to allow the Fashion Show to move from Tuesday afternoon at fair to another date TBD date and time at a later time, Twila seconded the motion, all ayes, motion carried.
